ANNOUNCEMENT

BELARUS EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS FOR FOREIGN CITIZENS

The Kenya Embassy in Russia invites applications from eligible Kenyan citizens to study in the Belarusian institutions of vocational training on higher education in the 2023/2024 academic year.

Application requirements

- 1. Application for admission to study (written in free form, reasons for choosing a specialty);
- 2. Copies of a document for travelling abroad and (or) National ID;
- 3. A copy of the document on education (certified copies of academic certificates);
- 4. A copy of a document confirming knowledge of the Russian and (or) Belarusian languages (if available);
- 5. Copies of a medical document on the state of health indicating the possibility of training in the chosen specialty and a certificate of absence of HIV infection issued by the official health authority of the candidate's country;
- 6. Recommendation letter from the place of study (for students);
- 7. Document confirming the pre-emptive right to participate in the competitive selection.

5 steps towards becoming a student

- 1. Choose your profession, university and programme
- 2. Learn about admission criteria and learning environment
- 3. Prepare documents and apply
- 4. Receive your invitation and get a visa
- 5. Pass the interview

Rules and regulations

- 1. According to the conditions of the competitive selection, the educational process must be carried out in the **Belarusian or Russian language**.
- 2. Expenses on transportation to the place of study and back, accommodation, ailment, medical insurance, visa issuance and registration must be met by the foreign citizen from their own resources or other resources nor prohibited by the law.
