A. HOW TO USE THE ELECTRONIC SYSTEM FOR VOTING

Step 1, Students login using registration number and their password

Step 2, Navigate to elections, then select voting.

Step 3, Select your preferred candidate for the electable position currently displayed on the screen.

Step 4, click submit vote.

Step 5, Repeat steps 3 and 4 until you have voted for all the electable positions

Step 6, Once you have voted for all the positions, you will see a list of all the candidates you have voted for.

Step 7, Remember to log out.

C. CAMPAIGN DOs AND DON'Ts

TIME

1. Crowd campaign is to be conducted between 4.00pm to 10.00pm (should not inconvenience the school's operations)
2. Individual campaign is to be conducted between 8.00am to 10.00pm (should not inconvenience the school's operations)
3. The SGC nominees should not campaign during delegates campaigns.

POSTERS

1. Posters should be placed on the designated places.
2. Do not mask, vandalize or ruin another person's poster (penalty is disqualification)
3. No use of loudspeakers in the school vicinity

USE OF TRANSPORT

1. No use of any modes of transport either within or outside the school.

THREATS

1. No use of abusive language verbally or written and hate speech towards other candidates.

APPEAL

1. Any appeal is to be passed through the appeal committee.
2. No withdrawal of a candidate whatsoever the reason.

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

Any violation of the election rules leads to automatic disqualification and further disciplinary action.
